A Fun Learn-By-Doing Workshop with Kumeyaay Instructors




Saturday, November 22, 2025 10:00 - 5:00 Tecate Community Museum

Beautiful hand-made Kumeyaay baskets will be used in the process and will be available for purchase directly from the artisans. The event includes a talk by anthropologist Michael Wilken-Robertson, author of Kumeyaay Ethnobotany.
